



Celebrating Poson

The Poson poya day became a historically significant day for Sri Lankan Buddhists because it was on a Poson Full Moon day, over 2000 years ago, in the 3rd century BC, that Buddhism was introduced to Sri Lanka. Emperor Asoka of India chose his son Mahinda, who was an Arahant, to lead the mission to establish Buddhism in Sri Lanka. For the mission to be a success, the Emperor wisely waited for the presence of an intelligent ruler in Sri Lanka, so the ruler may understand the Buddha's deep Dhamma. As an open and clear mind is necessary to understand the depth of the Buddha's teaching, it is use-





The King was engaged in a game of hunting when Arahant Mahinda met him at the royal park in Mihintale. Arahant Mahinda caught the King's attention by calling him by his first name, against royal protocol, and had the following conversation with him. Some regard this to be the first intelligence test recorded in history!



"What name does this tree bear O King?"

"The tree is called mango."

"Is there yet another mango tree besides this?"

"There are many mango trees."

"Are there any trees other than this mango tree and other mango trees?"

"There are many trees, Sir, but those are not mango trees."

"And are there, besides other mango trees and those trees which are not mango trees, yet other trees?"

"There is this mango tree Sir."

Having found the King to be suitable, Arahant Mahinda taught him the Buddha Dhamma and established the Bhikku Sasana in Sri Lanka, with royal patronage. The King declared Buddhism the state religion. Today Sri Lanka is considered the home of Theravada Buddhism.

Although understanding the Buddha's teachings intellectually is important, it is practicing the Nobel Eight-Fold Path that leads to the end of suffering. A meaningful way of paying our homage to Arahant Mahinda and celebrating Poson would be to do just that.

ඒ අතරින් මෑතකදී රසවිදිමට ලැබුනු පද්මා කුරුප්පු නම් ලේඛිකාව ගේ 'මද්දුම්' නවකතාව මගේ සිත් ගත්තේ හේතු කිහිපයක් නිසාමය. 70 දශකයේ සියනෑ කෝරළයේ ගමක ජිවත් වූ වරිත කිහිපයක් වටා ගෙතී ඇති 'මද්දුම්' නවකතාව එක හුස්මට කියවා රසවිදිය හැකි සරල බස් වහරකින් නිර්මාණය වූ අපුර්ව නව කතාවකි.



World Blood Donor Day

The World Blood Donor day 2021 will be celebrated on 14 June. It commemorates the birthday of Austrian Karl Landsteiner, the founder of modern blood transfusion.

Blood donations in Australia are under the auspices of the Australian Red Cross, now named Lifeblood. It takes only one hour to give blood, but it could save someone's life. Posters at the centre indicate that each donation saves 3 lives. You may be able to donate Blood, Plasma or Platelets and your blood type determines the best form of donation. Those who have certain antibodies such as Malaria are also permitted only Plasma or Platelet donations. Blood has a short shelf life (roughly 6 weeks). Therefore, donations throughout the year are needed to meet the needs of the patients. Donations can be done every 12

weeks. The extraction takes 10-15 minutes but the visit to the ARC Blood Bank may last up to an hour including pre-donation question-naire and a consultation with a nurse. Plasma can be donated every 2 weeks and Platelets can be donated every 7 days to a maximum of 24 times a year. For both, the extraction takes about 45 minutes.

Many Australians are regular donors. I had the privilege of meeting a Queenslander who had notched up 650 donations, a true legend. All donors experience a sense of great satisfaction by helping fellow humans. Please call Australian Red Cross Blood Donor Service (Lifeblood) on 131 495 and take that step. ලෝක පූජිත විතු ශිල්පියෙකු වූ ඉතාලි ජාතික Leonardo da Vinci විසින් වර්ෂ 1504 දී සිතුවම කරණ ලද, ඉතාලියේ FLORENCE නගරයේ ධනවත් වසාපාරිකයෙකුවූ Francesco del Giocondo ගේ රූමත් බීරිද Lisa del Giocondo ගේ බව කියැවෙන උඩුකය සිතුවම, ලෝක පුකට 'මොනාලිසා' සිතුවම පුංශයේ Louvre කෞතුකාගාරයේ තිබී හිටි හැටියේ අතුරුදන් විය. මේ සුපුසිද්ධ හොරකම සිදුවූ දින වකවානුව හරියටම කියනව නම්, ඒ 1911 වර්ෂයේ අගෝස්තු 21.

සොරකම සිදුවී දින ගණනකට පසුව, සිතුවම කෞතුකාගාරය තුල නොමැති බව වටහා ගත් නිළධාරීන්, පුංශ පොලිසිය සමහ මෙම සොරකම පිළිබඳ සොයා බැලුවද කිසිදු හෝඩුවාවක් සොයා ගත නොහැකි විය. මේ හේතුවෙන් නැතිවුණු සිතුවමට ලැබුණු පුසිද්ධිය අතිමහත් විය. ඉන්පසු කාලාන්තරයක් පුරාවටම එම සිතුවම පැවති තැන තිබුණේ හිස් තැනකි. පුතිපලය වුයේ, එතෙක් කල් කිසිදාක සිතුවමක් නැරඹීමට නොගිය මිනිසුන්ගේ සිට බාල, මහළු බොහෝ පිරිසක් මෙම හිස්තැන බැලීමට කෞතුකාගාරයේ නරඹන්නන්ගේ පෝලීමට එක්වීමය.

FLORANCEහි තිබෙන කෞතුකාගාරය වෙත සිතුවම රැගෙන ආයේ නගරයේ හෝටලයක සේවයේ නියුතු වේටර්වරයෙක් විසිනි. වාසනාවකට මෙන් මෙම සිතුවමට ඒ වනවිට කිසිදු හානියක්වී නොතිබිණි. මෙම සොරකමට සම්බන්ධවූ වේටර්වරයා Vincenzo Peruggia, කලක් Louvre කෞතුකාගාරයේම සුළු

සේවකයෙකු ලෙස සේවය කළ ඉතාලි ජාතිකයෙකි. පසුව, කුමක් හෝ හේතුවකට කරමින් උන් රැකියාව ඔහුට අහිමි විය.

මේ කියන දවසේදී, Leonardo da Vincied 'මොනාලිසා' සිතුවම මුල් පිටපත තැන්පත් කර තිබුණු කෞතුකාගාර කුටියට, Vincenzo Peruggia ඇතුල් වූයේ කෙළෙසින්දැයි කවුරුවත් දැන සිටියේ නැත. Peruggia පසුුව කී ලෙසින් නම්, එදා දිනයට කෞතුකාගාරය වසා දැමුණු පසු, ඔහු තමා සන්තකයේ සුරැකිව තිබුණු කෞතුකාගාර සේවක නීල ඇදුම ඇදගෙන රාත් වැඩ මුරයට එන සේවකයින් සමග, සේවකයින්ට වෙන්වුණු දොරටුවෙන් කෞතුකාගාරය තුලට පිවිස ඇත. පසුව, ඉතා උපකුමශීලිව 'මොනාලිසා' සිතුවම එල්ලා තිබුණු කුටියටවී, අනෙක් සේවකයින් සියල්ලන්ම නික්ම ගොස්, තමා පමණක් එතැන ඉතිරි වෙන තෙක් කල් මැරුවේය. එකල වර්තමානයේ මෙන් නවීන අනතුරු ඇගවීම නලා පද්ධති තිබුණේ නැත. ඒ නිසා ඔහුට සොරකම වඩාත් පහසු විය. ඔහුට කරන්නට තිබුණේ සිතුවම එල්ලා ඇති තැනට ගෙස් එය එතැනින් ගලවා ගැනීම පමණකි. ඉන්පසු, ඔහු ලගම තිබුණු

පියගැටපෙළ දෙසට ඇවිද ගියේය. කිසිවෙකුත් තොසිටි ඒ පියගැටපෙලේදී සිතුවම එහි රාමුවෙන් ඉවත් කරගත් ඔහු, ඒ කැන්වසය රෝල් කොට ඔතා, තමා ඇඳ උන් සුදු ලෝගුවක් සහිතවූ නිල ඇඳුම තුළ සගවා ගත්තේය. කිසිවෙකුටත් නොදැනෙන්නට කෞතුකාගාරයට ඇතුළු වූ දොරටුවෙන්ම නිරුපතිතව පිටවීමට සමත් විය.

ඉතා අහහිහකම් වලින් පෙඑණු Peruggia, මෙම සිතුවම සොරා ගැනීමෙන් අනතුරුව මෙය සොයාදෙන්නෙක්ට විශාල තාහග මුදලක් ලබා දේවී යැයි සිතා, එය එසේ වුවහොත් නැවත තමා විසින්ම ගෙනගොස් කෞතුකාගාරයට බාරදී එම තාහග මුදල ලබාගැනීමේ අටියෙන් මෙම සොරකම සිදුකොට තිබිණ.



Peruggia කෞතුකාගාරයෙන් පිටව යන සැනින්, Alfredo Geri නොපමාව පොලිසියට මේ බව දැනුම් අතර, Peruggia ඉක්මනින්ම පොලිස් අත්අඩංගුවට පත් විය.

'මොනාලිසා' සිතුවම, පෙර පරිදිම Louvre කෞතුකාගාරයේ තැන්පත් කෙරුණු පසුව, එහි ජනපුිියත්වය දෙගුණ තෙගුණ විය. යලි හමුවුණු 'මොනාලිසා' බලන්නට ඇදී එන නරඹන්නන් ගණන සීසුයෙන් ඉහළ ගියේය.

මේ අයුරින් යලි තැන්පත් කොට ඇත්තේ 'මොනාලිසා' මුල් පිටපත නොව වාහජ එකක් බවත්, මුල් පිටපත තවමත් සොයා ගන්නට හැකිවී නැති බවත් සමහරු කීහ. ඒ පිළිබඳ වාද විවාද කෙරිණ.



Stories Behind Names of Places in Sri Lanka: How Gileemale got its Name

Gileemale is a village in the Ratnapura Assistant Government Agent (AGA) division. This is a village that is well known for the cultivation of betel. Chewing betel leaves was a common tradition among the people of the county and the betel leaves played a prominent role in the culture of the country. A sheaf of betel was offered to receive people as a special mark of respect. This practice is carried on to date, and betel is offered as a respectful feature of invitation. For instance, even in modern Sri Lanka, wedding invitations to near and dear are done presenting betel. Betel plays a prominent role in spiritual and religious work in our country. "Deheth" is an important part of all alms offered to the monks. In offerings to gods, betel forms an important part. Then in Ayurveda treatment, some medications are served wrapped in betel leaves. Further, in country life, chewing betel is an act of leisure and pleasure.

Sinhala language is rich in "Idioms". "Gileemaleth etha datha suddo" meaning "that there are people with white teeth free from betel stains even in Gileemale".

There are two stories linked to the formation of the name "Gileemale". I hope to discuss only one story here.

It is linked to finding the pathway to "Sri Pada", the Adam's peak. According to the legends and history it was during the time of King Nissankamalla of Polonnaruwa, the foot print placed on the mountain top now called "Sri Pada" was discovered. The story is that the Angels were picking flowers from the King's garden



regularly to be offered to the Lord Buddha's foot print on the mountain top. The guards caught the angels and they gave the information of the Lord Buddha"s footprint on the mountain top and pledged to drop flowers from the sky showing the pathway to the mountain top.

With this news the King immediately instructed the soldiers to follow the flowers and reach this holy place. They were at last successful in their tedious mission. In the area now known as Gileemale the soldiers found difficulty in detecting the dropped flowers as they were sunk into the wet ground. So the area where the flowers were sunk to the ground (mal giluna bima) was called "Gileemale". It is recoded that later the King Nissanamalla himself climbed the mountain to venerate the footprint of the Lord Buddha.

In 2021, June 11 marks the Feast of the Sacred Heart, a devotional practice of the Catholic church highlighting "God's boundless and passionate love for mankind".

In Australia, National Reconciliation Week, marked from 27 May – 3 June draws the nation's attention to the rights of the Aboriginal people who have inhabited this land for over 60,000 years. The week is framed by the anniversaries of two significant milestones in the reconciliation journey - the successful 1967 Referendum (27 May) and the High Court Mabo decision (3 June). The theme for National Reconciliation Week 2021 is 'More than a word. Reconciliation takes action'.


