

# Special Fund (Food) Report as of 30 September 2023

### Midday Meal Program to Students



We are all familiar with the unprecedented multiple crises Sri Lanka is facing. A mere twelve months ago, we saw the peak of Sri Lanka's worst economic crisis in decades. 2023 continues to be a year dominated by poverty affecting the people in rural areas. Once Covid took hold, work dried up and consequently so did their income. A significant percentage of the population in these areas struggle with limited access to nutritious meals. It has been observed that the current economic crisis has led to multiple cascading effects and one of those is connected to falling school attendance. Local media has reported many incidences of students fainting at school because they come without having any food at home. In some areas, schools that did provide midday meals covered only the primary school due to financial and other constraints.

In a bid to address some of these issues, CandleAid Lanka initiated a Special Fund (Food) Program which was launched in June 2022 and commenced operations on 6 July 2022 with a gift of dry rations to destitute families in rural areas. To date we have given dry rations worth LKR 10,000 each to 1306 families from all places, all races and all religions at a cost of more than LKR 13 million.

In 2023, the Special Fund (Food) Program was expanded to include a midday meal for five consecutive days to students in rural areas. The meal is prepared at the school itself by a group of parents and volunteers. The areas covered so far are Ampara, Panadura, Hingurakgoda, Kalutara, Hiriyala, Angulana, Moratuwa, Waikkala, Mirissa, Kilinochchi, Vavuniya, Weligama, Imaduwa and the last project was just completed in Mawanella in September 2023. We have provided meals to 1297 students covering 17 schools.

These projects are implemented under CandleAid's guidelines, accounting for every rupee spent and are handled with the support of volunteer coordinators spread across Sri Lanka, numbering 105. The list of the volunteer coordinators is given below.
