Introduction:



Baila: A Sri Lankan Folk Music

Baila was the fortuitous creation bringing together the multicultural communities that existed during the time of Portuguese Ceylon. It famously combined the influences of Afro Rhythms, Portuguese violins and guitars, Malay drums, and the Sinhalese, Tamil, and English languages. Evolving out of Kaffringha, the progenitor of Baila, this musical genre is iconic of Sri Lankan culture.



Portuguese arrival in Ceilao (Ceylon) is dated to 1505 and no clear date can be identified when the musical style evolved, but it is safe to say that this means Baila is therefore at least 500 years old. This makes Baila one of the oldest continuous musical styles in Sri Lanka, predating more classi-

cal styles of music by centuries.

There are several forms of Baila including Papare and Calypso Baila, Waada Baila and energetic type of music which pits the musical and poetic skills of each singer against each other. Waada Baila artists are often provided a topic around which they must create rhyming verses to a musical backing that plays continually. The poetic skill wielded by Waada Baila singers is truly spectacular and I encourage readers to find clips on YouTube.

Then there is the ever popular Chorus Baila and Baila dancing among the classical forms of this truly Lankan music. The Portuguese word Bailar means "to dance" and this music is an integral part of the Sri Lankan Portuguese Eurasian and Afro Ceylonese community's dancing culture.

True to its folk roots, Baila music deals with the intricacies of the life of common individuals, as evident in the songs like Race Potha, discussing the damaging effects of gambling, or Muhude Yamu discussing the travails of the life of fisher folk. Similarly the song Asai Bayai and Podi Wije discusses national issues. Songs such as Kompanya Vidiya by Desmond De Silva discusses multiculturalism and reality of interethnic mixing with reverence and fondness. In doing so, Baila music functions like a time capsule for the sentiments of the population.



Baila exists in English, Sinhala, Tamil and other languages of Sri Lanka and thereby acts as a uniting force amongst communities.

It is important to consider that whilst other forms of music have existed in Sri Lanka, none have survived continuously over the centuries to remain intact and in

common use across the islands like Baila has. Baila music is ubiquitous in weddings, at celebrations, on road trips, and at family gatherings, bajau's and sing-songs.

That a musical style that is over half a millennium old is not considered an international treasure, regarded as historically invaluable and promoted, is the result of years of neglect. Often disparagingly called "Thuppahi Baila" and regarded as an immoral type of music due to its Portuguese origins and references to real life, Baila has often been discounted as an art form, thereby undermining its cultural transmission.

We hope that during our lifetime, this valuable form of music becomes internationally recognised for the invaluable contribution it has made to the tapestry of world music.

Stories Behind Names of Places in Sri Lanka AHANGAMA

Ahangama is a famous place in southern Sri Lanka in Galle on the boundary of Matara District. Habaraduwa, Koggala and Weligama are places around Ahangama. Today, it is a key tourist destination. Ahangama was significantly affected by the Tsunami in 2004.



As it is situated by the sea, the naming is linked to an incident faced by travellers who were coming to Sri Lanka by boat in the olden days. For example, Galle and Dondra and many places in the south were natural harbours for arrivals.

The story is linked to a certain clan of traders coming from India called "Lamba Karna". Lamba Karna meant "Long ears". Even the Lord Buddha is from that clan. So, they were travellers from India and known to have come in a boat made of stone. There would have been some system of making such boats at that time. Boat shaped stone items as archaeological findings are on display at Mihintalawa even today. We can imagine it as a vessel with better safety.

The sail of this ship got damaged on the way and the ship was floating in the area waiting for help. It is said that the passengers prayed to a God by the name "Weeramunday" to save their lives. However, the boat got gradually drifted to the southern sea and they spotted the land. They, in happiness, supposed to have shouted "AANNA GAMA", meaning, there the village. It is believed that the name AHANGAMA came into existence from that day.



The games, which were scheduled to be held last year, was postponed to this year, amidst the widespread rise in Covid-19 cases in China, though remaining as the 2022 Asian Games.

In a well-paced run, Dissanayake moved through the pack in the final 300m, before overtaking China's Wang down the home stretch.

India's Harmilan Bains finished second with a time of 2:03.75, while Wang had to settle for Bronze, clocking 2:03.90.
