Baby Viku

Viku's story is one of many. This 2 year old boy with a brain tumor needed to attend the main Cancer hospital which was 6 hours away. His mother was unemployed and did not have the means to bring Viku to the hospital. CDF came to the rescue to save his life with multiple trips regardless of the distance, time and cost. Living 200km away from the hospital, Viku's mother battling poverty in addition to her own health issues was a daunting task.

Surviving cancer after gruelling treatment is a huge milestone in a child's life. CDF takes pride in giving life changing support to children like Viku by receiving the treatment they need on time to extend their lives and resume living a normal life again.





Little Kusal

Little Kusal was only 8 years old when he was diagnosed with leukemia. unable to travel 40km regularly by more than one bus route, he was transported for more than a year for treatment. He is now free of the illness. He can go to school and play with his friends again. Timely treatment makes all the difference in the world.

Indra

60 year old Indra was battling Cancer during the peak of Covid. If it wasn't for CDF Indra would have had a painful end to her life without being able to get to the hospital


Within a very short period since its inception, the Foundation has been able to offer a helping hand for thousands of people suffering from cancer and other terminal illnesses.

Cyril Dharmawardana

When renowned actor and public personality in Sri Lanka Cyril Dharmawardana was diagnosed with stage IV lung cancer, he was grateful to receive the best care in Australia. Having witnessed the sad disparity of medical facilities in Sri Lanka & Australia he envisaged to provide a service that gave dignity and comfort to terminally ill patients at a time of pain and suffering. A facility that extended a helping hand to underprivileged communities experiencing financial hardship due to deep-rooted poverty. Within a year of Cyril Dharmawardana's sad passing in November 2013 his vision was made a reality by initiating and creating The Cyril Dharmawardana Foundation.

Cyril Dharmawardana Foundation (CDF) is an Australian based Non - Profit Charity organisation with the primary focus of assisting terminally ill patients with their transportation requirements between Hospital and home during their treatment. This is provided free of charge regardless of distance the patient need to travel. This facility currently operates in the Southern and North Central regions of Sri Lanka as well as to the main Cancer hospital in the Western Province of Colombo. With ongoing donor support, CDF plans to implement and extend this facility to other Cancer hospitals.

Reality for terminally ill patients after treatment is to travel long distances back home by Public transport in the Developing World. Often on dusty roads under unhygienic conditions. These patients have difficulty travelling physically due to illness and financially due to poverty, some would rather lie on a concrete floor in a hospital to recuperate or forgo meals to save for bus fare. CDF has pioneered the only Free Non-Emergency Ambulance service outbound from hospitals to homes.



WORK BEHIND THE SCENS





Considerable amount of work goes in reconditioning and reconfiguring the vehicles prior to shipment. Mechanical, body repair, rust management, electrical, electronic, metal fabrication expertise are required to meet the import control and customs requirements CDF GHARITY

EXISTING FACILITY



CDF is proud to provide well equipped world class Mercedes Benz and Toyota ambulances complete with patient carers.

The ambulances comply with QA standards are equipped withsafety belts and for patient's safety, mobile harness's cushioned stretcher facilities, dual air conditioning, heat and light protected ambience for patient comfort, hygienic environment, emergency siren & beacon (available if required) and extensive use of wheelchair access for patient mobility. CDF employs professional drivers and patient carers. An experienced volunteer management team member regularly travels on board for supervision.











PROCESS

Doctors & nurses recommend and issue a written directive to pick up and/or drop selected patients who are underprivileged and incritical condition. Patient consent forms and travel details are logged and recorded for reference at the hospitals. CDF plans and executes the journey based on patient drop off destinations in an efficient manner, minimising travel time for patients. Random checks are conducted by QA to maintain required standards.

All patient consent and travel details are logged on a daily basis. The data collected remains confidential. CDF also help hospitals to transfer patients when treatments are halted or when equipment is down





CDF help patients to get to an external scan or a test. CDF also provides snacks and drinks for patients who haven't eaten and dehydrated



CDF team work during weekends and public holidays when required



CDF team follows compassionate patients handling ethics to ensure patient satisfaction



CDF also allows patients to approach the highest level in the organisation structure for feedback and recommendations

Sadly, CDF encounters many tragic stories of patients on a daily basis, the most recent moving story is of a one month old baby with brain cancer, living over 100 km away from hospital in Udawalawe, she's grateful for the timely access to hospital to treat the baby. With the distance & baby's condition she cannot travel by bus.


Ranasingha was a patient in a palliative status with a week to live. CDF transported him from the hospital to be with his daughter in Mahiyanganaya, a 6hr journey (291 kms) so he can spend his last hours in peace and dignity.





Niluka's story is one of many, she was 10 years old when she lost a leg to cancer, she was unable to travel by bus with one leg, she became part of the CDF family being transported for over a year with numerous visits to hospital. Living 40 km away from the hospital, battling poverty, Niluka was able to escape the harsh reality of her condition being transported in comfort by CDF back & forth to hospital. She is now free of cancer and was recently transported 140 km away from home to a hospital to fit her new prosthetic leg, a dream come true to be able to walk again with both legs.








