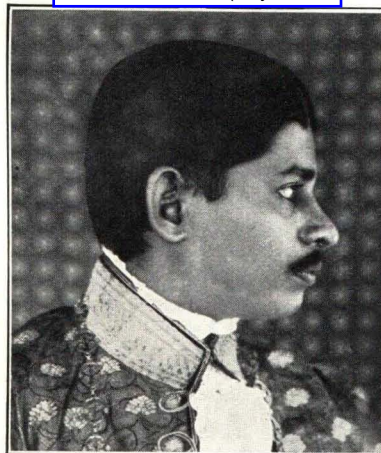

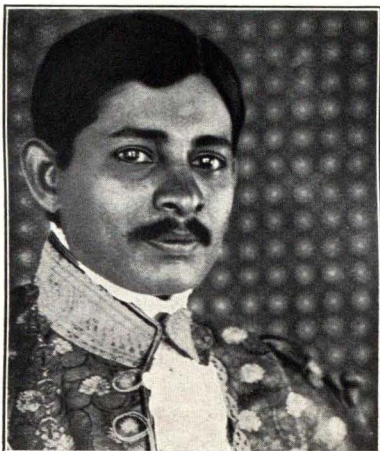

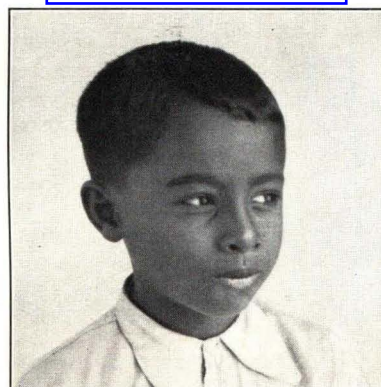

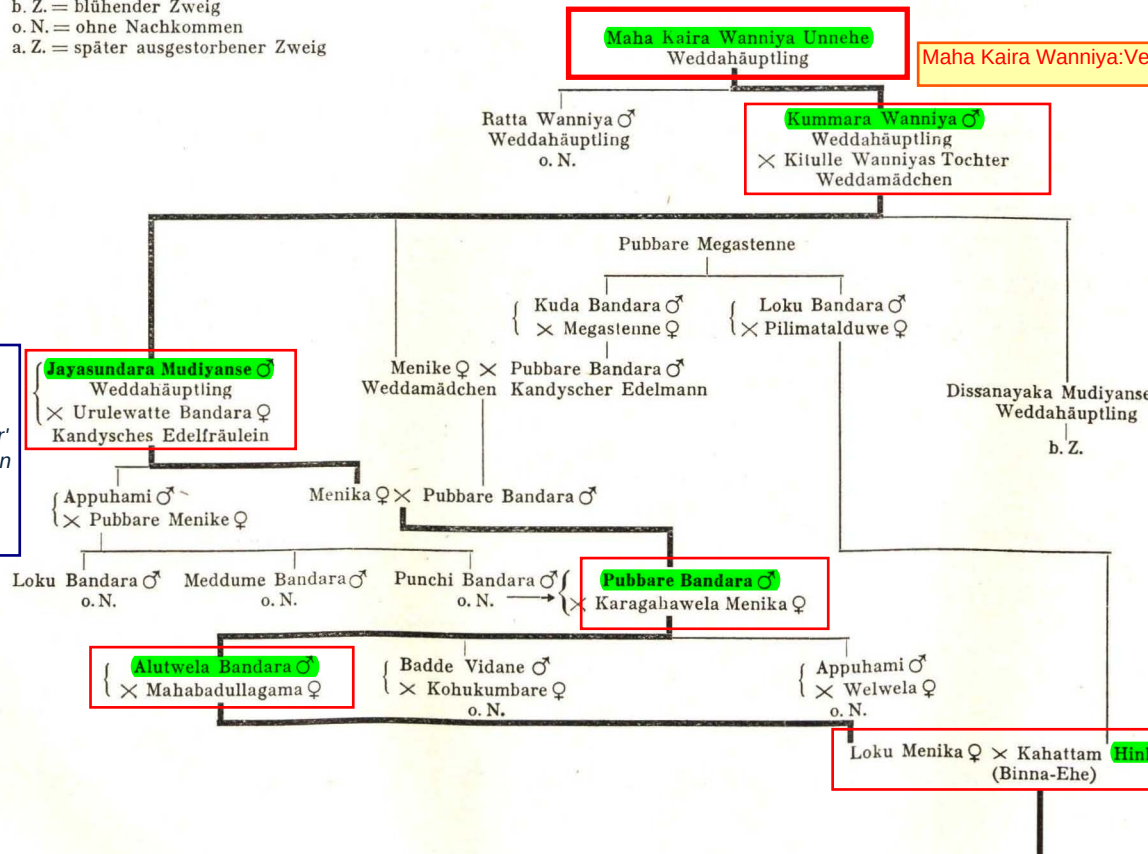

Maha Kaira Wanniya was a ruler of the Ruhuna country during the reign of King Rajasingha I (1581-1593 AD). For valuable services rendered in defending the Kingdom of Kandy from the Portuguese invaders, his descendants were granted, on sannas, the village of Bibilegama in the Wellassa Division in the year 1611 AD by King Senerat. The family of Maha Kaira Wanniya then took up residence in Bibilegama, and his descendants held the village until the abolition of the Ratemahattaya system in the 1930s.
