STUDENT SPONSORSHIP NEWS

In Colombo we currently sponsor 120 students, of these 12 students are at GCE "A" Level. In Batticaloa we currently support 45 students, 6 students are at GCE "A" level and a further 6 are undertaking tertiary studies.

In addition, the Eighty Club sponsors 10 students under the Clubs Post-Secondary Education Training Program (PSET). These students are all in University or similar tertiary Institutes. The PSET allowances are made from ECM funds in the PSET scheme, established by the late Mr. Ivor de Kretser.

Four students from Batticaloa have recently completed their tertiary studies; one in Software Engineering and 3 in mechanical engineering related courses.

Among students who have recently completed their GCE "O" Level examinations two students have had excellent results.

In Colombo Diendre Malisha Perera has achieved **7 A's and 2 C's**. Diendre is seventeen years old and has been sponsored since her kindergarten years by the ECM members Isabelle Prentice and Bartek Glinka.

She lives with her parents and sister, who is employed by the DBU. Her father operates a small Grocery store and her mother is a stay at home housewife. Diendre teaches in her church Sunday School.

She is now studying commerce subjects in her GCE "A" Level class and intends to continue to tertiary studies.



In Batticaloa Magni Fenishiya Vincent has achieved the best possible results of **9 A's** in her GCE "O" level examination. Magni is seventeen years old and lives with her parents and younger brother. Her father is a carpenter and mother a housewife. She attends St. Cecilia's School in Batticaloa and is currently studying at GCE "A" level in the Science stream and her ambition is to be a Doctor. In addition, she has won a merit award in the National Written Bible Quiz. Magni has been sponsored by ECM member Ms. Anita Young.

While we have featured two excellent examination results by our sponsored students; it must be mentioned that each year students complete either secondary or tertiary schooling and progress on to obtain gainful employment. This is possible each year, due to the generous contribution by our sponsors. These sponsorships help to improve the economic standing of the Burgher community in Sri Lanka; by providing financial support for the education and the development of employment

related skills in the children.

The student numbers have decreased from 189 at the end of 2022 to 155 at present.

I appeal to our readers and members to take on a sponsorship if you currently do not have one and also encourage friends/relatives to take on a sponsorship. There is a deserving student in Sri Lanka needing your support.

As previously reported, the eye camp by HelpAge, which was to be held at the DBU in October 2025 has been cancelled as reported by Etienne at the DBU. Hopefully there will be another eye camp early next year.


